Promotion of Activities Related to the Use of Natural Gas in the Transportation Industry

It is deemed appropriate to promote the activity related to the use of natural gas in the transportation industry in order to comply with the Cabinet's resolution to reduce the importation of oil.

By virtue of Paragraph 2, Section 16, of the Investment Promotion Act B.E. 2520, the provisions under Chapter 4 and Chapter 7 listings activities eligible for investment promotion, attached to the Board of Investment Announcement No. 2/2543, dated August 1, 2543, regarding types, sizes, and criteria of activities eligible for investment promotion, shall be amended to include the following:
