

Thailand is at the center CLMV, surrounded by the fastest-growing economies of India, China and ASEAN




Greater intra- and inter- regional connectivity are expected with synchronized visions laid by different countries...


ASEAN's & Thai's vision



Combined public and private investments

Approximately 1.7 Trillion baht (\$49.9 Billion) in the first 5 years



1 EEC major infrastructure projects

An international airport to accommodate up to approximately 60 million passengers.



The high speed trains will link the 3 main airports (Don Muang, Suvarnabhumi and U-Tapao) for greater convenience, reduced travel time and saving costs.



The state-of-the-art hub for aircraft maintenance, repair and overhaul. This is set to become the most advanced MRO center in the region.



The double-track rail lines will connect industrial zones nationwide to the 3 main ports



The expansion will lift its capacity to handle 18 million TEU containers per year and 3 million cars per year.




Increase the capacity to handle more liquid materials and natural gas.

Tax incentives

- Exemption of Corporate Income Tax at the maximum of 15 years with 50% Tax Reduction for additional 5 years
- **Exemption of import duties on machinery**
- Exemption of import duties on raw materials used in (1) production for exports and (2) R&D
- Costs incurred by certain research & development activities can be deducted as expenses (100 - 300 %)
- Special rate for Personal Income Tax of 15% / 17% for foreign executives / workers
- Targeted Technological Development Fund

Non-tax benefits (non-exhaustive)

Land ownership

- Rights to own land (for operating business) & condominium
- Lease up to 50 years + possible renewal for 49 years


Immigration

Rights to enter and remain in Thailand for the period specified / approved by EEC Office (even if longer than Immigration Law)

Foreign currency


Rights to use foreign currency for payment in EEC
