

**Interview Report of Royal Irrigation Department spokesman Boonsanong
Suchatpong on 25th September 2012**

According to Royal Irrigation Department spokesman Boonsanong Suchatpong, the water level in Pa Sak Jolasid Dam is currently at 500 million cubic meters, or 64% of the total holding capacity, equivalent to 785 million cubic meters. Meanwhile, the storage capacity of Pa Sak Jolasid Dam is equal to 960 million cubic meters so it can reserve more 460 million cubic meters. Currently, the amount of discharged water from the dam is at 12.96 million cubic meters per day.

At this time, the irrigation officers are keeping an eye on water situation and also the amount of rainfall closely in order to make sure that the volume of water discharged wouldn't overflow and cause flooding.
