

News Synopsis (Date: 28/09/2012)

Unofficial Translation from Krungthep Thurakij Newspaper

Saha Rattana Nakorn Industrial Estates has prepared a contingency plan, covering four levels as follows:

Level 0 - Normal water level where the rainfall is less than 10 millimetres per day and the water flowing into Ayutthaya is no more than 1,500 cubic meters per day: close monitoring but no impact on the industrial estate operations.

Level 1 - Water level in Chao Phraya, Lopburi and Pasak Rivers is below 5.5-6.2 meters above sea level: Close monitoring continues, preparation of emergency equipment

Level 2 - Water level is higher than 5.5-6.2 meters above sea level: Notifying to move machines and equipments to the high ground, stop main manufacturing units and prepare for an evacuation.

Level 3 - Water level exceeds 6.0-6.7 meters above sea level: Immediate evacuation and state of emergency announced. People will be moved to Baan Sung School, Baan Sung Temple and Baan Sung local administration.
