No Work Experience Requirement for Specialists

Offers opportunities to a wider range of talent to work in Thailand

- Applies to Highly Skilled Professionals
 - Work-from-Thailand Professionals

Expanding Eligibility to Educators

Now includes university professors and vocational educators to enhance knowledge transfer and workforce skills in Thailand

Applies to . Highly Skilled Professionals, including university professors, researchers, and educators in vocational sectors

Lowering Employer Revenue Thresholds

Reduces the revenue requirement for employers of Work-from-Thailand Professionals from USD 150 million to USD 50 million over three years

No Minimum Income Requirement for Wealthy Global Citizens

Removes the USD 80,000 annual income requirement, and focuses on stable assets and long-term investments of at least USD 500,000

Expanding Family Benefits

Now includes parents and other family members to ensure a smooth relocation experience for families

Exclusive Benefits of the LTR Visa

A 10-years visa with unlimited re-entry

Personal Income Tax rate capped at 17% for Highly Skilled Professionals



Immigration reporting reduced to once a year
